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## March Kindergarten Registration for Fall Semester 2018

Bexley offers all-day kindergarten for all students who turn five years of age on or before August 1, the year of enrollment. New students to kindergarten should be registered at the elementary school of attendance. The child does not have to accompany the parent/guardian to register.

To support efficient on-site registration, families with the last names ending with A through L are invited to register March 6, and families with the last names ending with M through Z are invited to register March 7:
